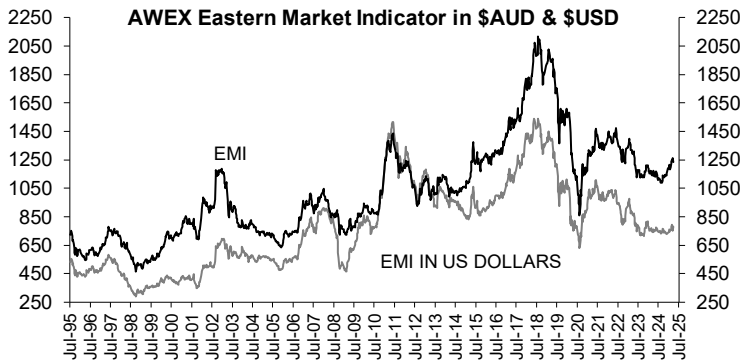

### COMMENTARY

Wool sales in the Northern region were conducted at Sydney's Royal Easter show this week, giving the public an opportunity to watch proceedings. The wild ride in exchange rates continued with the Aussie dollar 6.5% dearer against the US dollar since the close of the previous selling week. This placed immediate pressure on wool prices when the market opened on Tuesday. In local currency the Eastern market indicator lost 22 cents or 1.7% for the day but it was the complete reversal in US dollars with the market climbing 34 cents or 4.6%, gaining all of what it lost last week. Price levels continued to slightly weaken on the final selling day. Better style, higher strength and lower vegetable matter types outperformed the market quote with larger discounts applied to lots carrying imperfections. 35,028 bales were sold nationally for the week with the fluctuating market resulting in a high passed in rate of 17%. Major buyers included Endeavour Wool, Tianyu and Techwool. Sales now enter a brief one week recess for the Easter period resuming the week of the 28<sup>th</sup> of April. **We wish you all a happy and safe Easter. This report will recommence on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May.**



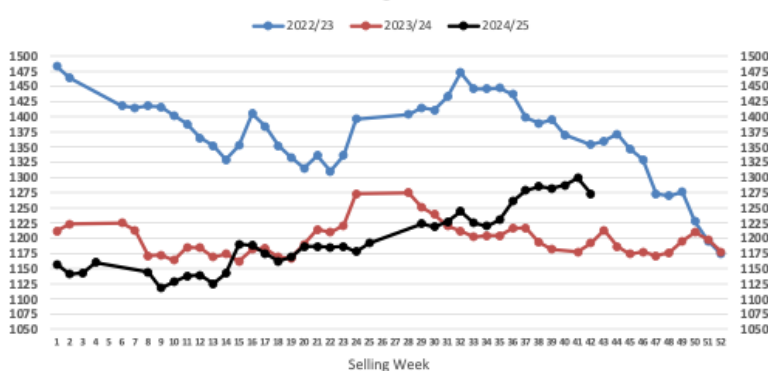
